Excellency:

With reference to the exchange of views between the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Korea and the Embassy of the Republic of the Philippines concerning the waiver of non-immigrant passport visa fees, I have the honor to propose that our two Governments agree, by exchange of notes, to the reciprocal waiver of non-immigrant passport visa fees for the citizens of either country visiting the territory of the other for business or pleasure for a period not exceeding fifty-nine (59) days.

I further propose that this agreement be made effective as of the date of Your Excellency's Note in reply and that it remain in force unless altered or terminated as a result of mutual consultation.

If the Government of the Republic of Korea is prepared to accept the foregoing proposals, I have the honor to suggest that this note and Your Excellency's con-
